- We made a £871 "profit" on training, and collected £910 in membership fees.
  This enabled us to donate £1187 through the ethical fund to various causes
  including Palestine (HIRN, Gaza, Hebron friends) and cowfolk going through
  tough times, while still maintaining a healthy balance for ongoing costs.
- Jo told a very heart-warming story about how a woman who plants flowers and does gardening for the community on Stapleton road, who had had her

- spade stolen, and left a note asking if someone would be so kind as to return it.
- The cowgirls wrote underneath it 'If you haven't got your spade back, we'd like to buy you a spade.'
- Jo bought her a new spade with ethical fund money.
- To which Mary replied: 'How did you know what spade I wanted?!'
- The end of the story: Mary from Stapleton Road is very grateful.
- The twisted oak brewery kindly gave us the donation money.

## 3. Training

- Currently two sessions game only Tuesday, coach led training on Thursday
- mark is main coach, bear has been helping out in last few months
- As we have had issues not all that long ago with an additional coach and a
  perceived lack of transparency about this situation amongst players it was
  discussed that we should be more transparent with any changes to coaching
  situations this time
- Agreed that having women coaching women is a great and empowering thing
- Suggested that chair/vice chair could have discussion with mark and bear about how they would like to work together, plans for coaching style/setup, and this could be fed back to players so they are aware
- Discussed the FA coaches conduct and coaching being inclusive of all abilities and fitness
- Agreed players should be encouraged to give feedback on coaching to coaches or committee, and for feedback to be taken on board
- Query whether a coach would be helpful on Tuesday sessions however, this
  has been voted on in the past and agreed Tuesday is game only session
- Players are encouraged to ask others for informal coaching and advice in game only sessions if this is helpful for them

- People to be made aware of who the new committee is, and who they should go to if they want to give feedback on coaching.
