As everyone was cheering the verdict against Derek Chauvin this month, Ngaio the amazing Woman behind Booty Base shared her thoughts -

"Allies, I'm looking at you.

All the people who went on the marches, put up the squares, said #blacklivesmatter with full chest, let's go.

Am I relieved about the verdict? Yes. Am I happy? No. I am livid.

I am livid thinking about all the people who will be patting themselves on the back and talking about how great this verdict is, but who have done nothing to actually support the Black people in their lives.

Have ignored and/or silenced Black voices in order to retain an image of themselves as 'not part of the problem'







Have never taken the time to really think about the part they play in keeping this status quo in play or considered how unsafe their ignorance make spaces for others

Have read a few books, said the right words and have still not ventured into, and out of, their guilt.

I'm not saying it's easy, I have to unpack my privelege everyday but I do it because that is the work.

When white people consistently bring their energy and horror to the fight against racism and actually DO something, then we will move forward. I think today of all the people who have been failed and who will not see justice for unlawful death. My thoughts are with the family of #GeorgeFloyd and every other Black person out there who feels as triggered and confused as I do.

It's the verdict that was lawful. That is all."

### Kill The Bill

Join the Movement to end the Police, Crime and Sentencing Bill

### What We are Protesting For

Through persistent protest, we have already forced the delay of the Police, Crime and Sentencing Bill!

The Government is still trying to pass this oppressive law and is hoping You will forget - The Bill is not dead yet, only sleeping.

This bill is a serious attack on Your rights and freedom.

We must continue to act to stop this law being passed.

### How The Bill Will Affect You and Others

### Repression of Protest

The Bill will allow police to impose conditions on pickets, protests and demonstrations. This will repress the ability to defend our rights and improve our lives; amongst those who will be repressed are Workers' Unions and organisers, Renters' Unions, and those protesting against state & gendered violence. The restrictions will play into the hands of the already-powerful - Corporations, Landlords, and Police, amongst others.

### Criminalisation of the Gypsy, Roma & Traveller Community

The Bill will criminalise Gypsy, Roma and Traveller (GRT) communities by making trespass a criminal offence - making the way that thousands of people have lived for hundreds of years illegal, and continuing the historic violence and persecution against GRT people.

### We Will All be at Greater Risk of Arrest

The Bill will give police the power to impose fines and sentences on any individual who is making a "noise" perceived to cause disruption to nearby businesses or organisations. For Example, if You have been badly treated by a service and You decide to publicly speak out about it, You could be fined up to £2,500. If You are judged to have "incited" others to protest, You could be jailed for up to 51 weeks. The threshold for arrest under these rules is totally arbitrary, and up to the judgement of the police involved.

### More Powers for an Already Oppressive System

The police and prison system already violently targets Black, Brown, Gypsy, Roma, Traveller and in fact all working class communities. The police need less power, not more; this bill is a step in the wrong direction for equality in the UK.

### **Unfair Extreme Sentencing for Property Damage**

The Bill will threaten people who damage statues of racists like Edward Colston with up to ten years in prison. The toppling of the Colston statue was an amazing moment of collective action against white supremacy. **The government's response is even more repressive**, sentencing anyone who dares to reclaim their history.
